



New Business To Bring 350 Jobs To Upstate

Anderson Chosen After 2-Year Search

ANDERSON, S.C. -- A Florida-based business will bring 350 new jobs to Anderson County, officials said Tuesday.

Cross Country Home Services Inc. will convert an old Winn-Dixie store in the Windsor Place Shopping Center on East Greenville Street in Anderson into a 24-hour customer care center.

Anderson was chosen as the site for the call center after a two-year search.

The center will take calls regarding home warranties, service plans, and assistance programs provided by Cross Country Home Services.

Tri-County Technical College in Anderson will provide employee training.

The call center is expected to open by July 1.

Christine Sullivan, vice president of Site Selection Group, Inc., said, "Our search results and analysis identified Anderson, S.C., as offering our client the best strategic location, favorable business climate, ample skilled workforce with low competitive saturation and an equitable incentive package.
