Regency Energy Partners moving to Bryan Tower

Natural gas company **Regency Energy Partners LP** is moving its headquarters to Bryan Tower in downtown Dallas, almost doubling the size of its office space to accommodate its growth.

Regency (Nasdaq: RGNC) said it is staying in downtown Dallas, moving from 1700 Pacific Avenue - which has been under lease since August 2003 - to the 37th and 38th floors of 2001 Bryan Street.

The move expands Regency's office space to more than 54,000 square feet with expansion rights for future growth. The new headquarters will house about 90 employees.

"Regency has experienced significant growth over the past several years through a number of acquisitions and organic growth projects," said Byron Kelley, chairman, president and chief executive officer of Regency. "We are expanding our office space to accommodate our recent and future growth."

Regency said it expects to complete its move by October.
